The Challenge:

In Nigeria alone about 53.4% of youths while in Africa nearly 420 million youth aged 15-35, one-third are unemployed and discouraged, another third are vulnerably employed, and only one in six is in wage employment. Youth face roughly double the unemployment rate of adults, with significant variation by country.

In some parts of Nigeria more than half of the youths drop out of school at junior secondary level. Some have given up hope of a better life, others unfortunately engage in the act of banditry.

Nigeria/Africa youths like other young people all over the globe have enormous potential to shape their future and be productive members of the society.





Our Response:

Bank On Youths is a community based four years initiative that seeks to improve the life and job prospects of the highly vulnerable youths, as a model that value grass participation of young people to effectively make decisions that will address issues affecting their environment.

Synergetically Bank on Youths is open to partnership to both local and foreign firms, with an overarching focus on promoting the employability and civic engagement of the youths in Africa starting from Nigeria.

What do we seek to accomplish?

Bank On Youths has five (5) minutes key goals:

- Provide greater access to life, employability and entrepreneurship skills, leadership skills through training, internships, and job placement.
- Deliver youth friendly services that effectively respond to young people needs and are relevant to their lives with intention of giving them a meaningful livelihood.
- Support young people in improving their communities through skills acquisition, small scale infrastructure and reliability project.
- Generate knowledge and lessons learned around youth empowerment programs that can be used to improve policy development and promote systemic change; scale up successfully models; and be shared with the global community.
- Celebrating young achievers who has proven outstanding excellence in the areas of youth empowerment.



Who do we benefit?

Bank on Youths aim at improving the lives of African youths especially the most marginalized and underserved youths with 15-40years of life.

Target environment

Based on high level of poverty and unemployment, social status such as violence, neglect, and school dropout rates ; population density; and representation of urban and rural areas.

To develop programs that fully address the unique challenges of young people in each Community we conducted in-depth survey of the members of the community, we collected information on critical challenges. This Rapid Community Assessment (RCA) painted a stark picture of young people's unmet daily needs.

Bank on Youths target areas where families and vibrant youths can not afford to keep their children in school, protect themselves, motivate themselves to pursue their dreams of becoming exceptional leaders. Areas of inadequate public services, few opportunities to improve their skills or become civically engaged.

Young people identified smoking, alcohol, drug abuse, community and domestic violence;and crime as negatively impacting their lives.

Lack of youth empowerment and services expose young people to frustration, depression and greater chances to engage in crime and other loathsome acts.

Our interactions with most young people who are involved in crime, shows they are interested in furthering their education,



acquire skills, engage in sports, recreational activities, and are willing to be engaged civically if availed the opportunities. With the effect of mentoring others to give up on crime.

For the first two years (2019-2021)our programs effectively touch lives of youths internationally, ranging from orphanage homes, foreign students, Internally displaced persons, and skills acquisition towards youth empowerment.

How we operate?

Bank On Youths is designed to promote community driven collaboration, ensuring a wide range of stakeholders contributes significantly to avail meaningful opportunities for young people.

We work with private and public organisations to provide critical advice and technical assistance offering vision and guidance.

To fully respond to community needs and build on existing assets, BOYs do not only identify challenges, we also actively provide economic based and proven solutions for young people. This knowledge became the basis for developing BOYs community action plan which provide intervention, best approach to target areas and also setting preventive/prophylactic measure to curtail the rates of growth and recurrence.

BOYs have representative in each state of Nigeria and some part of Africa to implement, oversee and report the progress/ challenges in executing our action plan in their communities.
